SUREWANI TOURISM GATE

Surewani Zone comes under Maharashtra part of Pench National Park. It is the extended part or buffer zone of Pench Tiger Reserve. The forest is dense and beautiful with a variety of flora and fauna. The forest is home for tigers, leopards, wild bears, chitals, sambars, sloth bear, wild dogs, and many bird species.

The best way to explore the flora and fauna of the national park is to travel through jeep safari. Jeep Safaris operate in two shifts, one in the early morning and another one in the evening. The Jeep Safari is done only with vehicles registered with the park administration as private vehicles are not allowed inside the park. The number of vehicles allowed into Surewani is 7 in the morning and 7 in the evening. Each jeep can take up to 6 travelers other than a driver and one naturalist. Afternoon safari is closed on 26th January & 1st May every year and completely closed on every Monday. Besides, one can also go for a night safari in this zone of Pench.



NIGHT SAFARI

Night safari is also known as the Wolf Safari as wolves are among the animals frequently spotted on this tour, along with jackals, spotted deer, sambar deer, nilgai and many nocturnal birds. Tigers and leopards are infrequently spotted.



GARDEN

A specially created play zone for kids, this space arouses their curiosity and sensitises them with the concepts of the wild.

Night safari is also known as the Wolf Safari as wolves are among the animals frequently spotted on this tour, It is strictly restricted to the buffer zone. Buffer zone is the periphery of the core area in the forest. The safari also covers a water hole in the buffer zone where tourists get the chance to spot the animals as well as get an excellent location for stargazing.

MACHAN

The machan watch, a new eco-tourism experience in Surewani, is sure to be as exciting as the adventure trip. In the buffer zones, the Surewani mountains will feature machans where people may sit and view the wildlife creatures.


A machan accommodates multiple individuals with a guide and provides more observation of the surroundings owing to its heights, and because it is disguised, travelers may see the creatures at their natural greatest. Foreign tourists would bring their own snacks, water, and plastic sheets to sit on and would stay on the machan for the time allocated to visitors.

The vacationers would expect to be paid for the machan watch as well as the coach and the gipsy cars which would transport visitors to the spot
